

Sexual Assault Awareness

What you need to know while you are under the supervision of SCDOC

If you've just been sexually assaulted:

- Request immediate medical attention - *You may have serious injuries that you are not aware of, and any sexual contact can expose you to sexually transmitted diseases*



IT IS NEVER TOO LATE TO SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION

- Do not shower, brush your teeth, use the toilet, or change your clothes - *Evidence may be destroyed by mistake.*
- Report the assault immediately to a staff member - *Delayed reporting makes it difficult to obtain all the evidence for the investigation.*

THE SCDOC AND ITS STAFF WANT TO KEEP YOU SAFE!

Both victims & witnesses of a sexual assault have reporting options

All reports are investigated

- Report the incident to any trusted staff member
- **Submit a Medical Slip or Inmate Request**
